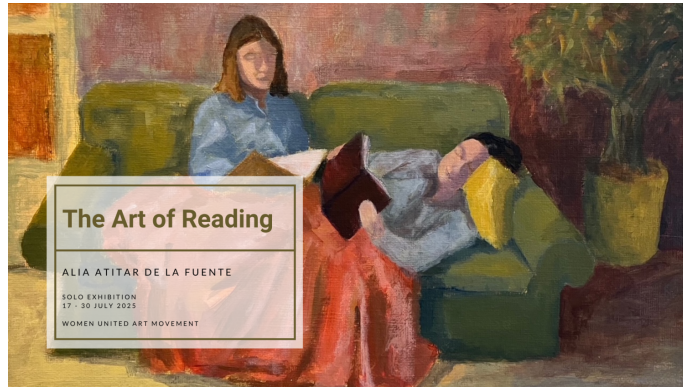

Alia is a Spanish-Moroccan artist. She earned her Qualification in painting from the École des Arts d'Ixelles in Brussels.

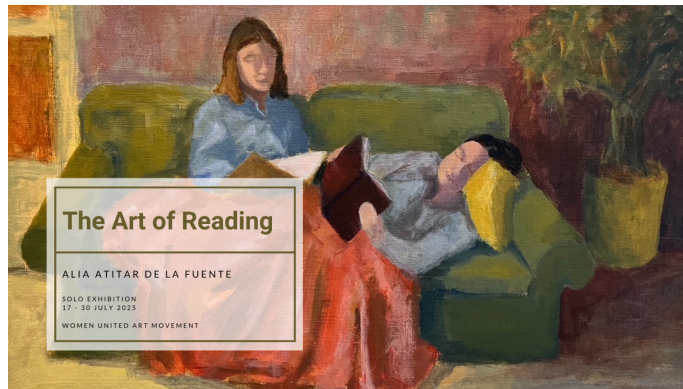

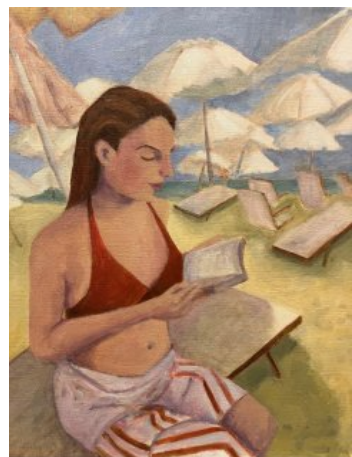

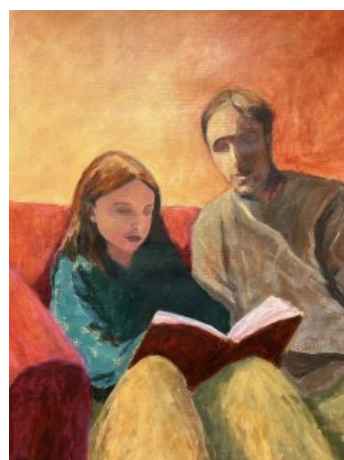
